Appellant requested extension; granted by order 6.20.18 - extension to 7.30.18

Appellant requested 2d extension; order 7.24.18 - extension to 8.29.19

initial briefs and designations filed in September 2018

ROA due by 10.18.18

10.6.18 Appellant requested extension to 11.16.18

11.19.18 extension granted to 12.19.18 "no further extensions will be granted absent a showing of extraordinary circumstances."

12.19.18 Appellant moved to dismiss appeal and remand. Denied by order 2.13.19;
ROA to be served by 3.15.19

3.14.19 Appellant moved for leave to file a Rule 60(b) motion in the trial court. Denied by order 5.9.19. Ten days to serve ROA.

ROA purportedly served on 5.20.19.

Appellant's final brief and ROA to be filed by 6.10.19.

As of mail delivery on 6.13.19, Respondent's attorney has not received Appellant's final brief.

How long will this be allowed to go on? Appellant is now complaining that he does not have a transcript of the magistrate's court hearing - a complaint that he has not made until now. I do not see that appellant cited to the magistrate's court transcript at all in his initial brief.
