That Drakkar Corshad Austin did in Cherokee County between December 29, 2018, and December 30, 2018, knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase or bring into this State, or did provide financial assistance or did otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or did knowingly actually or constructively possess, or did knowingly attempt to actually or constructively possess four hundred (400) grams or more of methamphetamine, a schedule II controlled substance, in violation of §44-53-375, *THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976)*, as amended.
