## ORDER



After entering guilty pleas, petitioner filed a notice of appeal. The South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal finding that petitioner had failed to provide a sufficient explanation under Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).<sup>1</sup> Petitioner has now filed a *pro se* petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of this dismissal by the Court of Appeals.


