
APPELLANTS' MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF



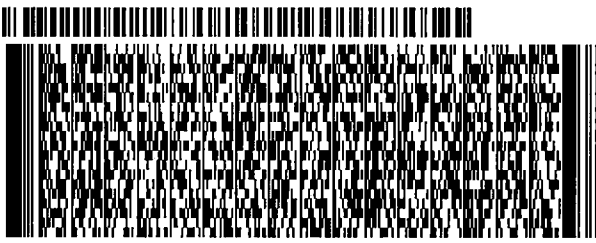

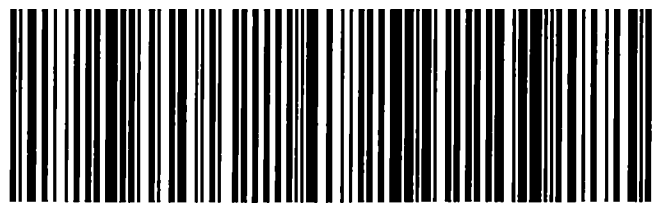
