Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The document is not on 8.5" by 11" paper as required by Rule 267(c), SCACR.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee amount is \$250.00.
- Pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR, the notice of appeal must be filed with the clerk of the trial court.
- Pursuant to Rule 208 (a)(1), SCACR, your initial brief documents are not to be filed at this time. Within thirty (30) days after receiving the transcript or, if no transcript is ordered, within thirty (30) days after serving the notice of appeal, the appellant shall serve one copy of his brief on all parties to the appeal and file with the clerk of the appellate court one copy of the brief with proof of service.
