## ORDER

In the instant matter, on March 11, 2019, this Court issued an order relieving counsel and continuing the case to allow the appellant, which is a limited liability company, to inform the Court of the name of new counsel. After multiple attempts to provide a copy of our order to the appellant, notably the Court's letters dated March 12, May 7, and May 29, 2019, the appellant failed to notify the Court of the name of new counsel.<sup>1</sup>

Our May 29 letter warned the appellant the appeal would be dismissed if no attorney made an appearance on behalf of the appellant. To date, no attorney has made an appearance on behalf of the appellant. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. *See Renaissance Enters., Inc. v. Summit Teleservices, Inc.*, 334 S.C. 649, 515 S.E.2d 257

<sup>1</sup> The order relieving counsel was mailed to counsel for the appellant, to the individual addresses of the members of the LLC, to the address on file for the appellant with the Secretary of State, and to two addresses obtained by an internet search for National Dental Systems, LLC d/b/a Dental Smart. Many, but not all, of the Court's attempts to contact the appellant were returned as undeliverable. The appellant did not file a response to any of our four separate attempts to mail out the order relieving counsel.
