
COUNT I - MURDER

That MALETTE DENISE KIMBROUGH a/k/a MELETTE DENISE KIMBROUGH did in Greenville County, on or about the 19th day of November, 2016, unlawfully and with malice aforethought kill RUBY FLAMM by means of shooting her once in the head with a handgun, and that RUBY FLAMM died as a proximate result thereof. This is in violation of §16-03-0010 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT II – POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That MALETTE DENISE KIMBROUGH a/k/a MELETTE DENISE KIMBROUGH did in Greenville County, on or about the 19th day of November, 2016, possess or visibly display a handgun during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, to wit: Murder. This is in violation of §16-23-0490 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
