number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Joey Clark v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on April 24, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Jimmy Byron Keith Curles with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




