MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for John M. Cureton respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until July 24, 2019**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for John M. Cureton respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Aundra Hunter, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on June 21, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Venson Tyrone Jones with the Court of Appeals on May 31, 2019. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of McIver R. Feagin, Jr. v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on May 17, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Ryan P. Deleston v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on May 13, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Dean Alton Holcomb with the Court of Appeals on May 2, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Mitchell Logan Hinson v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on April 26, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Joey Clark v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on April 24, 2019.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.




