Dear Ms Jenny Kitchens and the SC Court of Appeals:

The last contact Appellant received from this court in the above matter was February of 2019. Appellant sought through Third Parties to "appeal" then circuit court judge now chief administrative judge Jocelyn Newman's prejudicial ruling affecting the merits of the case, "dismissing several [responsible and should be held accountable] SCDC individual employees for several intentional acts to serious harm and/or attempt to kill Plaintiff.

The First Third Party, also a professional, Dr. Lindy Wang (Office No (803) 385- 2515).

After some difficulty Dr Wang paid the \$100 appeal filing fee that according to the Clerk's Office, "could only be paid by US postal money order by mail."

Several efforts were made in "arrangements for the relevant May 15, 2018 hearing transcript by Dr Wang and Appellant.

Specifically, Appellant wrote requesting such from the court reporter, Angela P Berry @ 734 Boines Rd Prosperity, SC 29127. Ms Berry responded. However, failed to provide a business phone number nor a business email.

Appellant was advised "arrangements were being made to obtain the transcript at the lowest possible method, in digital form due to Appellant's complete poverty status, that was honored in the lower court, with intent to reduce MS Berry's initial \$120.00 "estimated cost of the transcription.

Dr Wang did her best, as elder person, eighty years young, a first time engaging with the appeals court, to explain the situation and make satisfactory transcript arrangements so Appellant could be lawfully and truthfully heard on appeal for the first time civilly.

The clerk's office and Dr Wang seemed to have a misunderstanding or other complication.

Additionally, Appellant wrote the SC Court of Appeals arch of 2019.

Also in March Appellant forwarded a factual narrative of the consistent struggles receiving equality to a Third Party "Tousha, requesting her assistance from the Honorable appeals court to, preferable, allow Appellant to be heard on appeal as a poor person or . . . in the alternative, because Appellant was NOT HEARD on appeal in this case, for an alleged technicality "not ordering the transcript within ten (10) days, SCARP, Rule 207, at least refund Dr Lindy Wang's \$100 she paid in good faith in good to have Appellant heard by filing an Appellant Brief.

Personally, based on my experience and understanding of the circumstances, it may appear, as previously, that Dr Wang, a sweet and loving elderly taxpayer who is a professional may have been taken advantage of by a person(s) in the clerk' office,

Therefore, in closing Ms Kitchens and Court, your cooperation in justly having Appellant ultimately heard on appeal in this matter or refund Dr Wang's \$100 because Appellant was never heard on appeal, would be appreciated.

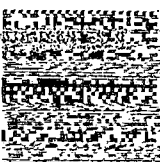
