FOR THE OFFICIAL RECORD, the Appellant informed and noticed this Honorable Court that he entered into Bankruptcy in April of 2018 and was unable to pay the filing fee for this appeal. Notwithstanding, the State of South Carolina, the SC Department of Revenue and the City of Columbia Police Department caused imminent injury and loss to the Appellant which was the direct reason for filing the Bankruptcy Matter in the first place.

By right, due to the fact that such an injury exists from these governmental entities coupled with the issue of being bankrupt, at once should have provided relief in this area where payment was required.

Nevertheless, this Court was notified of the Bankruptcy and Appellant's was unable to pay made the official record in April of 2018 by motion for leave to fill *in forma pauper* to waive fees and cost due to the fact that there was no money available.

Since that time, Appellant have had to find work out-of-state to avoid confrontation with OPD SOCRATES GROUP's Agent Jerry McCroy which certainly would not allow for payment of this fee back then during the bankruptcy and clearly not now. All of the evidence shows the governmental parties named in this action were then and continues to behave negligent fashion while also seeking to avoid accountability.

LET ALL MEN KNOW BY THESE PRESENT and the Official Record that the within Appellant is unable to pay for this appeal and there is yet another issue with the bogus transcripts that do not recite the words spoken; word for word as it were at the hearing where the Court refused to honor her oath along with the SC Constitution. The Order at issue was received by Appellant on June 16, 2019 upon returning to the State, while dated June 11, 2019.

Now if the Court is saying it issued an order during March of 2019, Appellant did not receive such a notice of order and it is very likely Appellant did not receive that notice due to the change in the Postal Employee who worked this street and area for more than 20 years was changed and assigned to a smaller delivery route due to his age and health issues. 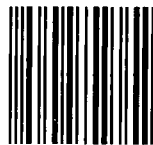
