

ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion asking this court to compel the Workers' Compensation Commission (the Commission) to release all transcripts and files related to Albert Bradley's claim for benefits. In addition, Appellant has moved for a hearing to request subpoenas for documents in Respondents' possession related to this case. After careful consideration, the motions are denied. *See* Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR ("Where a transcript of the proceeding must be prepared by the court reporter, appellant shall . . . make satisfactory arrangements . . . with the court reporter for furnishing the transcript."); Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record [on Appeal] shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").¹ Respondents have filed a motion to dismiss this appeal or, in the alternative, set a deadline for the filing of Appellant's initial brief. Respondents' request to dismiss the appeal is denied; however, Appellant shall serve and file her initial brief within thirty days of this order, and the failure to do so may result in

the dismissal of this appeal.
