


INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on JUL 30 2018, the Grand Jurors of Oconee County present upon their oath:

**DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, 1ST DEGREE**

The defendant, Michael Allen Owens, did on or about May 24, 2018, in Oconee County, South Carolina, cause physical harm or injury to, or offer or attempt to cause physical harm or injury to Heidi Erin Owens, a household member, with apparent present ability under circumstances reasonably creating fear of imminent peril. And, in addition, great bodily injury resulted or the act was accomplished by means likely to result in great bodily injury; or the defendant has two or more prior convictions of domestic violence within the prior 10 years; or used a firearm; or, in the process of committing Domestic Violence in the 2nd Degree, one of the following resulted: the offense was committed using physical force, or the threatened use of force, to block the victim's access to any cell phone, telephone, or electronic communication device for the purpose of preventing, obstructing or interfering with the victim's efforts to (a) report a criminal offense, bodily injury, or property damage to a law enforcement agency, or (b) request an ambulance or emergency medical assistance from any law enforcement agency or emergency medical provider; and/or the offense was committed while impeding the victim's breathing or air flow. All in violation of Section 16-25-20 (A) and (B) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
