Upon reviewing your amended appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed. This is the Court's second request for these deficiencies:

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- The attachments filed along with your appellant's initial brief cannot be considered as part of your brief. Therefore, we are returning them to you.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the brief should be titled "Appellant's Initial Brief".

- The caption does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption must match exactly with the one given below:
