Extension Must Be Based On A Showing Of Good Cause.

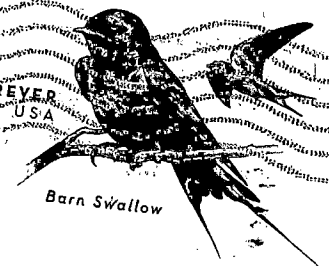
My Showing Of Good Cause Is That I Was Housed In A
