At today's visit, she stated that the Cymbalta she is currently taking is not helping her depression but that she used to take Prozac, which has helped her in the past. I am changing her medication regimen to switch her from Cymbalta to Prozac. In order to make the change, she will have to taper off her current Cymbalta dosage before she can begin to take the Prozac. I estimate that it will take four weeks for the Prozac to get into her system. Please excuse her from any court actions for the next five weeks until the medication change has been completed.
