

ORDER

This court construes Appellant's February 26, 2019 motion as a request to proceed *in forma pauperis*, to file fewer copies, and for an extension of time. First, the motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Second, the request to file fewer copies of the final briefs and record on appeal is granted. Appellant is entitled to file only one original and one copy of the final briefs and record on appeal. Appellant must still serve Respondent with copies of all filings with the court. Finally, Appellant's request for an extension of time to serve the record on appeal is granted to the extent Appellant shall serve the record within thirty days of the date of this order and file a proof of service. All final briefs shall be served and filed within twenty days of service of the record on appeal.
