TO BE INCLUDED IN RECORD ON APPEAL


Appellant hereby moves pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for an extension to  
July 12, 2019, of the time in which to serve and file Appellant's initial brief and  
designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. The grounds for this  
motion are that there is good cause to grant the requested extension, as the following  
shows:

1. Appellant's counsel has done substantial work on the initial brief in  
this case, but he does not anticipate being able to finish it today. He  
needs to prepare for important depositions tomorrow and spend  
significant time drafting another document due tomorrow on a  
deadline in a different case.

2. The extension sought would add less than two weeks to the current deadline, just long enough to push this deadline beyond the Fourth of July holiday, two other significant writing deadlines of Appellant's counsel, and a crucial motion hearing set for July 10 in another case.
3. This is the fourth extension of this deadline that Appellant has sought in this appeal. Counsel does not see why another extension would be needed.
4. Appellant's counsel believes there is good cause to grant the requested extension of this deadline.

WHEREFORE Appellant prays for an order extending the time in which to serve and file Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal to July 12, 2019.


