My name is Saire Castro. I am currently incarcerated at Kershaw Correctional Institution. My reason for writing you is to find out the status of my writ of certiorari. In 2013 my PCR was denied. My, personally, was not able to file any paperwork due to institutional lockdowns. I was told that my PCR attorney was supposed to file my writ of certiorari on my behalf. I haven't heard anything since. I need to know the status of my paperwork inside the court. What steps do I need to take from this point. I'm completely at a loss. I took a plea for voluntary manslaughter and received 30 years in 2012. My attorney was Randall Mullins, Horry County. The judge was Durham Cole from Spartanburg. My lawyer at 'PCR' was Daniel Zelwa. I don't have any case numbers or information because my property was lost moving from Lieber Correctional to Kershaw Correctional. I would greatly appreciate your assistance in finding out the status of my paperwork within the courts, and letting me know what to do. Thank You.
