I write in response to your letter dated July 1, 2019. Obtaining the transcript in this matter has proven to be a long and arduous process. However, I have attempted to remain diligent and keep this Court informed of my efforts.


I originally requested this transcript the day after the hearing, on October 16, 2018 from the Court reporter. I received no response. The post office did not return it.

I received a letter from this Court on February 1, 2019. I responded to that letter and copied the court reporter, including an additional request. I received no response. The post office did not return it.

On April 3, 2019, while preparing to send another request to the court reporter and copy court administration, I discovered that this court reporter retired and is no longer listed on the S.C. Courts website. I contacted Jeffrey LeBlanc, Circuit Court coordinator for Court Administration. I learned that the court reporter in this matter, Hilda Jordan, retired without transcribing this matter or responding to my request. Mr. LeBlanc provided me with instructions for how to obtain a transcript from a retired Court Reporter. I followed his instructions, requested the transcript, copied this Court on the correspondence, and provided an update.

On May 13, 2019, I received an email from Desiree Allen indicating that I also needed to fill out a "transcript request form," and that my prior transcript request had a typo in it. I filled out her transcript request form, corrected the date, and e-mailed it back to her on June 6, 2019.
