Dear Mr. Roberson:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service does not give the date that you served a copy of your notice of appeal on the respondents' counsel. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the Greenville County Clerk of Court's Office has not been provided as required by Rule 203, SCACR.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- The argument that you have presented in your filing cannot be considered as part of your notice of appeal. You must serve and file a notice of appeal in

accordance with Rule 203 of the SCACR and that is substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
