My name is Justin Pringle, I'm writing this letter to show

The arguable basis, that there are issues reserved for appeal. I'd like to start by saying that I was apprehended in Columbus, Ohio on January 12th, 2018. When they came to arrest me they gave fake names to force their way into our home, they also didn't have any arrest warrant or anything. On record they have that I was apprehended on January 14, 2018, which is not true. Video footage and arrest records will prove when I was actually taken into custody. I was served a search warrant for DNA samples on August 13, 2018, but it had my co-defendant name on the warrant and the warrant wasn't signed and approved by the judge until August 14th, 2018. If you pull my case file you'll see the papers filed. I was transported to Florence County Jail February 4th, 2018 which no G.S.R. was collected to prove my innocence on my behalf, about not firing a firearm. Also prove my innocence or guilt. On multiple occasions my co-defendants were caught telling lies + making up false alibis + stories which making them non-credible. The victim brother which is "Amos Cameron," stated that he heard a loud vehicle pull into the yard that sounded like the muffler was missing. Which was the description of Anthony Hudson's vehicle which DNA was taken from the vehicle, nothing came back matching my DNA to conclude me being associated anywhere near that vehicle. A few moments later he heard knocking at the front door, then he heard arguing so he got up + opened his bedroom door, he observed his brother holding a black male by the neck, then heard gun shots. 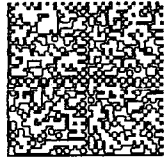
