I recently received notice that I am scheduled for a kidney transplant July 10, 2019, at MUSC in Charleston. After the transplant, I expect to be prescribed immune-suppressive drugs and anti-rejection drugs, which may require me to be medically quarantined for several weeks. Accordingly, I respectfully request protection from required court appearances and filing deadlines July 9 through August 15, 2019.
