**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S  
MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

On March 7, 2019, Willie Wilson appeared before the court accompanied by his attorney, Assistant Public Defender Stephen F. Krzyston, with Attorney Luck Campbell present on behalf of the State. The Defendant was convicted and sentenced to fifty, thirty, and fifteen years at the Department of Corrections for the above captioned warrants, with sentences to run concurrently.

On March 15, 2019, counsel for Defendant filed a Motion for Reconsideration based on the above sentences. The Court reviewed the charges and accompanying sentences and considered the Defendant's request. Having fully considered Defendant's request, the Court finds that the sentence imposed is not improper or excessive. *See, e.g., Brooks v. State of South Carolina*, 325 S.C. 269, 271-72, 481 S.E.2d 712, 713 (1997) (citing *Garrett v. State*, 320 S.C. 353, 465 S.E.2d 349 (1995); *State v. Sidell*, 262 S.C. 397, 205 S.E.2d 2 (1974)) (finding that a trial judge is allowed broad discretion in sentencing and that sentence is not excessive if it is within statutory limits and isn't based on prejudice).


