As to your client's request to have counsel appointed based on his indigency, no action will be taken on this request by this Court. Instead, since this appeal involves an appeal of a criminal conviction in municipal court,¹ it is your responsibility to contact the Division of Appellate Defense (Appellate Defense) of the Office of Indigent Defense so that it can determine if it will provide representation. If it determines that it will provide representation, you will be automatically relieved as counsel in this case. *See* Rule 602(e)(4), SCACR. If Appellate Defense declines to provide representation in this appeal, you may then file a motion seeking either to be relieved as counsel and/or seeking to have counsel appointed in this case. I am forwarding a copy of the Affidavit of Indigency that you have provided to Appellate Defense.
