
Re: The State v. Yolanda Shatten - Appellate Case No. 2019-000825

Dear Ms. Allen:

Thank you for your recent letter pertaining to the above-captioned case. On June 17, 2019, we mailed an affidavit of indigency in the proper form to Joseph Henry, Esquire for his client, Ms. Shatten, to complete and return to our office by June 25, 2019. Mr. Henry was subsequently informed that Ms. Shatten mailed us a partially filled out affidavit of indigency on the wrong form. Again, Mr. Henry was provided with the proper affidavit of indigency form, and he has been instructed that Ms. Shatten must completely fill out that affidavit of indigency form, and have it returned to our office if we are to screen her for indigency for her appeal. Subsequent to the June 25, 2019 deadline referenced above, our office has since made two other attempts to follow-up with Mr. Henry to obtain the affidavit of indigency, July 1, 2019 and again on July 15, 2019.

At the present time we still have not received the completed, notarized affidavit of indigency in this case, and I am therefore unable to screen Ms. Shatten to determine whether she is indigent. If you need additional information, or have any questions please contact me.
