

(1) Prosecutorial Misconduct by Knox McMahon wrote affidavit for arrest and then took it to trial, he was head Prosecutor at trial.

(2) Subject matter Jurisdiction - Arrest Warrant was not signed by Magistrate.
A warrant is properly issued only when signed by the Magistrate, only upon a sworn affidavit
§(17-13-140) - Const. Art. 1. §16 (now Art. 1 §10)

(3) Sentencing under 16-3-20(A) - 17-25-45 - life, (My Charge) under warrant and indictment for Murder (16-3-10) - sentencing (17-25-20) 20 years Judge Cooter enhance sentence - you can't change statute during sentencing phase

(4) Issue of Warrant sign by Ministerial Recorder can only put forth, not endorsement for Magistrate.

Art. 8 - Everyone has the right to an effective remedy by the competent national tribunals for acts violating the fundamental rights granted him by constitution or laws.
