I am writing you in response to a letter I received from Attorney Tommy Thomas' office stating the Supreme Court had asked him to notify me of the ramifications of withdrawing my Appeal. 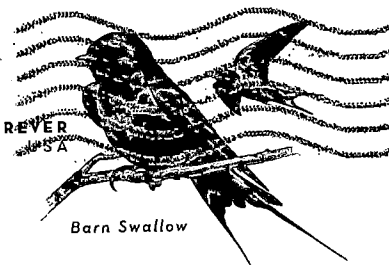
