NOW COME Appellants, Jennifer McFarland and Carlton Holcombe, by and through their undersigned counsel, on the grounds stated below, and, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, hereby move this Honorable Court to allow them a final extension of one (1) business day's time, i.e., until Monday, July 15, 2019, to file/serve their initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

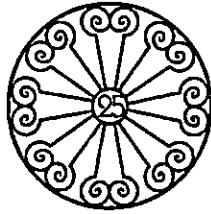
