shows:


1. Appellant's counsel had previously sought an extension through July

2. Appellant seeks an extension through July 19 simply out of an abundance of caution, to make sure that the brief gets completed.
3. This is the fifth extension of this deadline that Appellant has sought in this appeal. Counsel does not see why another extension would be needed.
4. Appellant's counsel believes there is good cause to grant the requested extension of this deadline.

WHEREFORE Appellant prays for an order extending the time in which to serve and file Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal to July 19, 2019.

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
