
The Initial Brief of Appellant, and Designation of Matter, in this matter are due for service and filing on today's date, July 17, 2019. Due to ongoing medical issues, Counsel for the Appellant has not been able to complete her work on this brief by this due date. For that reason, Counsel now asks for an additional thirty (30) day extension of time in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant in this appeal. Opposing counsel, William M. Blich, Jr., Senior Assistant Deputy Attorney General, has previously indicated that he would have no objection to such additional extensions as might become necessary due to Counsel ongoing problems with her hip. Counsel attempted to contact him today to confirm that he had no objection to this specific request and was unable to reach him. Counsel's hip replacement surgery, originally scheduled for June 7, 2019, has been delayed due to unexpected complications which must be resolved before the surgery can be rescheduled. While Counsel has made progress in resolving that issue, she has not yet been cleared to have her surgery rescheduled. Counsel is on a limited work schedule until after she has this surgery and recovers, however, she will make every effort to complete this brief before going on full time medical leave for approximately three weeks for her surgery and recovery. Counsel has discussed the reasons for this additional extension request with her client. He understands the need for this additional delay and does not object to Counsel's request. Counsel deeply appreciates this Honorable Court's patience and kind assistance pending her surgery and recovery.
