MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Richard T. Stribling respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until August 21, 2019**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Richard T. Stribling respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Dean Alton Holcomb v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on June 24, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Aundra Hunter, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on June 21, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Desmond J. Sams v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on June 6, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Venson Tyrone Jones with the Court of Appeals on May 31, 2019. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of McIver R. Feagin, Jr. v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on May 17, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension, until August 21, 2019** in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


