After receiving the Respondents letter dated 6/28/2019 and motion to strike and speaking with your clerk / staff they described the process the court follows and mentioned the Court will review the Record on Appeal I submitted and advise me by letter if adjustments / page numbers / references to exhibits etc. are necessary.

And if so, I would be allowed reasonable time to make those adjustments and resubmit. I will Follow your direction on this and wait your review and communication to me.

A strike of this appeal would continue to severely prejudice me and neglect fact finding where many material facts are unquestioned.

The lower court's Summary Judgement for the defendants is on appeal after the judge failed to rule on and compel the defendants depositions where all have refused. And the first cousin of the judge in the lower case had become a witness just days prior.

If I may direct you and the Appeals Court's to a recent (June 10 and June 17, 2019) public and televised Beaufort County Council meeting where a defendant in this case Mr. Dave Thomas, BC Procurement Director reported to BC Council certain core matters and items directly related in this case and in doing so contradicted his and other affidavits submitted in this case. Mr. Thomas perjury relates directly to the core of this appeal.


All defendants have refused depositions and the lower court failed to rule and compel where many questions remain.
