TRAFFICKING COCAINE (10-28 GRAMS)


That in Sumter County, South Carolina, on or about March 12, 2015, the Defendants, **INDIA KIERRA GILCHREST and DEVIN RAUL RODRIGUEZ**, unlawfully and knowingly did sell, manufacture, cultivate, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State; or did provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, cultivate, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State; or did possess or attempt to possess a controlled substance or a controlled substance analogue, to wit: Cocaine, in excess of ten (10) grams, but less than twenty-eight (28) grams; in violation of 44-53-370 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT TWO
TRAFFICKING COCAINE BASE (CRACK) (10-28 GRAMS)

That in Sumter County, South Carolina, on or about March 12, 2015, the Defendant, **DEVIN RAUL RODRIGUEZ**, knowingly did sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State; or did provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State; or did possess or attempt to possess a controlled substance or a controlled substance analogue, to wit: Cocaine Base, in excess of ten (10) grams, but less than twenty-eight (28) grams; in violation of 44-53-375 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
