


**Motion for an Extension of Time to File Petition for a Writ of Certiorari**

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 242(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Petitioner Rodney L. Galimore (“Galimore”) hereby moves this Court for an order granting an extension of time to file his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in the above-captioned matter. Galimore respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension to the time to file the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. 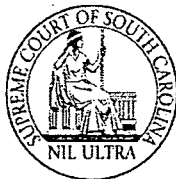
