MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Kenneth Campbell respectfully requests a **final two (2) day extension, until July 26, 2019**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. **Counsel will file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter before the deadline if possible.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Kenneth Campbell respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. **Counsel had an allergic reaction that required a trip to the emergency room and the use of medication with sedating side effects. Counsel expects to be back at work by tomorrow and should be able to quickly finish this brief.** Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari to this Court in the case of The State v. John Kenneth Massey, Jr. with the Supreme Court on July 5, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Gene David Evans, Jr. with this Court on July 3, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jeffrey Cromer v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 28, 2019. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of The State v. Allen Stone with the Supreme Court on June 20, 2019. Counsel filed the return to petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Daniel Hamrick with this Court on June 7, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. M'Andre Cochran with this Court on May 20, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Vincent Missouri before the Supreme Court on May 8, 2019.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final two (2) day extension until July 26, 2019**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of


