Upon reviewing your respondent's motion for extension of time to serve and file initial brief and designation of matter, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion will not be considered:
