

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## ORDER

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Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal is denied. However, we strike the Record on Appeal filed June 11, 2019, due to Appellant's failure to comply with Rule 210 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Within twenty days of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an Amended Record on Appeal that (1) includes all documents listed in Respondent's designation of matter, (2) does not include documents which were not presented to the circuit court, (3) is consecutively paginated, and (3) contains a certificate of counsel. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209. . . . The Record shall not, however, include any matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal. . . . Each page of the Record on Appeal shall be consecutively numbered beginning with the index."); Rule 210(g), SCACR ("Appellant or his counsel shall certify that the record on appeal contains all material proposed to be included by any of the parties and not any other material.").
