
Dear Deputy Clerk Allen:



Your appeal will be dismissed if no motion is made within ten days of the date of this letter.

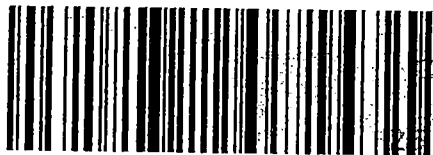

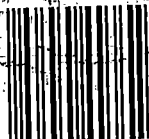
