ORDER

This Court denied Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari on May 17, 2019. When no petition for a rehearing was made within the time provided by Rule 221, SCACR, the remittitur was sent to the circuit court on June 4, 2019. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

Subsequently, Petitioner sent two letters to this Court—one dated June 17, 2019, and the other dated June 27, 2019. Because appellate jurisdiction ended on June 4, 2019, these filings are stricken and dismissed.
