Dear Mr. Allison:

I received a copy of your letter, dated February 4, 2019 and without a copy of the envelope indicating a postmarked date when it was forwarded to me on March 11, 2019. Also forwarded was Ms. Allen's reply letter to you dated February 11, 2019. As to your transcript inquiry, let me offer the following information:

Transcripts are prepared pursuant to written requests only. A deposit for the estimated cost of the transcript must accompany each request. For transcripts done by me, all deposits must be in the form of a money order or certified check payable to: Vivian H. Cross, Circuit Court Reporter (Retired). Transcripts are then prepared in order of receipt.

Reviewing my notes, this hearing will be somewhere around 135 pages. This may vary up or down depending on the amount of 'lull' time in the hearing -- that is, the amount of off record conferences, etc. that took place and the general pace of the hearing. Original transcripts are billed at a per page rate of \$4.25 per page plus postage for mailing. Therefore, the deposit that is required for this transcript is \$585.00. This is an estimate only. Any shortage would need to be paid prior to the time of delivery of the transcript. Conversely, any amount received in excess of the actual cost would be refunded at the time of delivery of the transcript.
