Finally, pursuant to S.C. Code of Laws §16-3-25(C)(3) and *State v. Copeland*, 278 S.C. 572, (1982), the Court finds that the sentence of death as applied to Mr. Jenkins is not excessive or disproportionate to the penalty imposed in similar cases where a death sentence was imposed. See *State v. Sims*, 304 S.C. 409, (1991), *cert. denied*, 502 U.S. 1103, (1992); *State v. Patterson*, 285 S.C. 5, (1984), *cert. denied* 471 U.S. 1036, (1985); *State v. McWee*, 322 S.C. 387, (1996), *cert. denied*, 117 S.Ct. 695, (1997); *State v. Humphries*, 325 S.C. 28, (1996), *cert. denied* 520 U.S. 1268, (1997); *State v. Thompson*, 278 S.C. 1, (1982), *cert. denied* 456 U.S. 938 (1982).

The Defendant's motion is DENIED.
