I am very saddened to inform you of a very unfortunate and unforeseen situation that is occurring in my life at this very moment.

My daddy, Mr. Eddie Holloway Sr. Died on February 25, 2019, Just two days before The Probate Court Hearing For permanent guardianship and Conservatory. .

My father in law, Mr. Samuel passed away shortly thereafter, on April 10, 2019.

I wish I had the resources to write a book about my life since 2009 until present. However, I would make it a learning and positive read.

As you know from my correspondence, I am disabled. I've also been in a car accident on August 10th, 2018. This accident has left me with a need for neck and back surgery, therefore a lot of my time has been consumed with physical therapy and neurosurgeon appointments.

I then applied just recently, for appointment over my father's estate. It was granted to me this on June 12, 2019. Unfortunately, there is a 90-day limit on some of the probate work. I am so very overwhelmed but blessed to be assigned over my father's estate. While doing inventory on the estate, I've discovered that the brother, Victor Holloway stolen over \$70,000 of dad's assets. Now I found myself not only in a probate case, but also, I had to file criminal charges. He had the nerve to divide our father's assets between himself 2 brothers and 2 nieces leaving me and the baby brother our of our father's Will.

Therefore, I am desperately in need of an extension on my appeal case. I'm asking no, I am begging for 90-days in order to give my attention to this most important appeal case.
