ORDER

On June 21, 2019, this court received a motion from Respondent to appoint counsel to him. On June 24, 2019, this court received another motion from Respondent seeking the records of any discussions regarding his prior motions, dismissal of the State's appeal, appointment of counsel, correction of the appendix, and that the appeal be held in abeyance. This court has already ruled on prior motions by Respondent to appoint counsel and correct the appendix; accordingly, we decline to act on these requests. *See* Rule 240(i), SCACR ("The court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal."). This court will not consider additional motions on these issues or any other issues upon which the court has already ruled. Moreover, after careful consideration, Respondents motions are otherwise denied.¹
