number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Aundra Hunter, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on June 21, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Desmond J. Sams v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on June 6, 2019.
