The rate you stated is that which the SC Appellate Court-employed court reporters charge, not private court reporters. Government-employed court reporters are salaried and with benefits, with those page rates included on top of their salary. Private court reporters are not paid salaries or benefits, and so our rates help to make up that difference. We were hired by a private law firm to cover this trial, as I guess a court-employed reporter was not available. Attached is a copy of our rates page. Hello Linda,

As discussed over the phone, there were a couple of short sections already transcribed, but the overwhelming majority of it was not. At this moment we have an excerpt of the cross examination of Kathleen Martin taken 02/08/2016 and trial excerpt of Jeremy Roof taken 02/09/2016 completed. Our reporter estimates it to be about 1,000 pages, give or take left to transcribe. Our original + 1 copy rate for trials is \$6.15/page. Any exhibits would be added to the cost. Given all of that, I'd estimate the total to come to somewhere around \$6300, probably. It would probably take her around one month to get this all completed.

Please let me know if you would like for her to move forward with transcribing these trial dates or have any further question. Thanks!
