ORDER

The motion to exceed the page limit contained in Rule 242(f) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules is granted to the extent that respondents-petitioners may file a return to the petition for a writ of certiorari filed by the petitioners-respondents which does not exceed forty-five (45) pages. The time to serve and file this return is hereby extended until August 30, 2019.

The motion by the petitioner-respondents for ten (10) additional days to file a reply to the return of respondents-petitioners is granted.

After the extensions granted in this order, both sides have exhausted the twenty day period provided by this Court's order dated July 16, 2014.¹ Therefore, any further extensions in this case "will be granted only if extraordinary circumstances such as illness or other circumstances beyond the control of the movant warrant the granting of the extension. The parties are warned that the press of other business is not an extraordinary circumstance which will warrant the granting of an extension. These extensions will generally be granted for no more
