ORDER

Petitioner has filed a document seeking review of the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in Appellate Case Number 2018-002136. Since review of a decision of the Court of Appeals is sought by serving and filing a petition for a writ of certiorari under Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), this notice of appeal has been construed as a petition for a writ of certiorari.

Petitioner has failed to provide a proof of service showing that a copy of the petition has been served on the opposing counsel as required by Rule 242(c), SCACR, and the petition does not have the content specified by Rule 242(d), SCACR. Further, petitioner has failed to file an appendix having the content specified by Rule 242(e), SCACR. Finally, petitioner has failed to pay the filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
