**ORDER DENYING MOTION TO  
RECONSIDER**

This matter is before the South Carolina Administrative Law Court ("ALC" or "Court") on Appellant's motion requesting this court reconsider its Order dated June 11, 2019. The Order affirmed the Final Administrative Decision issued by the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services' Division of Appeals and Hearings. Appellant contends the undersigned failed to consider the arguments that were contained in its brief and subsequent reply brief. However, contrary to Appellant's assertion, the record was thoroughly examined, and arguments made by the parties in their respective briefs were given particular attention prior to the court issuing an order that addressed each of Appellant's issues and arguments. Because Appellant's arguments were in fact considered and addressed in the order, the motion should be denied.

Appellant additionally request this court reconsider its denial of oral arguments. *See*, SCALC Rule 39, *fn.* "Oral argument is discretionary with the presiding judge, ..." Appellant has added nothing that convinces this court that oral arguments would cause it to reconsider the order already issued in this matter, and therefore the request should be denied.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Appellant's Motion to Reconsider is **DENIED**.
