**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
INITIAL BRIEF OF RESPONDENT AND
DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

The undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension in which to file the Initial Brief of Respondent in the above-referenced case. Opposing counsel, Robert Dudek, Esquire, has graciously consented to the request. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary or good cause circumstances:

Respondent's Initial Brief is due today, Friday, August 9, 2019 as per this Court's Order dated July 17, 2019 granting Respondent's second extension request. The undersigned attorney for the Respondent has completed part of the Initial Brief of Respondent, but has had a number of state and federal matters to attend since July 10, 2019. Specifically,

1. Counsel for Respondent has been out of the office on medical leave and is on a reduced work schedule due to a continuous and on-going health condition. Counsel was out of

the office **the entire week of June 10-14, 2019** for week long medical tests and screenings at Duke University Medical Center, Durham, North Carolina for a heart and kidney transplant. Counsel received word June 20, 2019 that he has been approved for transplant and placed on the transplant waiting list. Counsel was also out of the office **on Thursday, June 20, 2019 and Thursday, July 25, 2019** for appointments in Charlotte, N.C. at the Carolinas Medical Center (CMC) for treatment of an infection due to the same or related on-going health condition. Counsel was out of the office on **Thursday, August 8, 2019** for an appointment and further test at Duke University Medical Center, Durham, N.C.;

2. Counsel prepared the Respondent's Response to Motion to Alter or Amend [ECF #54] in the matter of Andre King, #258599 vs. Warden McFadden, C/A No. 1:14-91-JMC-SVH (Federal Habeas Corpus) on **July 15, 2019**;

3. Counsel filed the Return and Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment in the matter of London Wooden, #357930 vs. Warden, Perry Correctional Institution, C/A No. 4:19-927-RMG-TER (Federal Habeas Corpus), also on **July 15, 2019**;

4. Counsel filed the Respondent's Reply to Response in Opposition to Motion for Summary Judgment [ECF #35], in the matter of Arthur L. Singleton, #300109 vs. Warden of Lee Correctional Institution, C/A No. 9:18-3300-RBH-BM (Federal Habeas Corpus) on **July 24, 2019**;

5. Counsel filed the Respondent's Reply to Petitioner's Objections to Report and Recommendation [ECF #41] in the matter of Dennis M. Temple vs. Warden Scott Lewis, C/A No. 8:18-03258-JFA-JDA (Federal Habeas Corpus), also on **July 24, 2019**;

6. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter in the Horry County murder appeal matter of State vs. Nicholas Jacob McIver, Appellate Case No. 2018-000824 on **July 24, 2019 in this Court;**

7. Counsel filed the Return and Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment in the matter of Dexter Brown, #330278 vs. Brian Stirling, C/A No. 2:19-01613-RMG-MGB (Federal Habeas Corpus) on **July 31, 2019;**

8. Counsel filed the Respondent's Reply to Response to Motion for Summary Judgment [ECF #50] in the matter of Maxwell E. Sipes, #320502 vs. Warden of Tyger River Correctional Institution, C/A No. 8:18-2842-RBH-JDA (Federal Habeas Corpus) on **August 2, 2019;** and

10. Counsel has been involved in working on other matters in state and federal court as well.

However, due to counsel's medical condition and treatment, and counsel's involvement in these and other matters, counsel is unable to timely complete the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter in this matter. Opposing counsel has graciously consented to this request.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, counsel respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension of time to serve and file the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter. This request is made in good faith, and not for the purposes of delay.






